

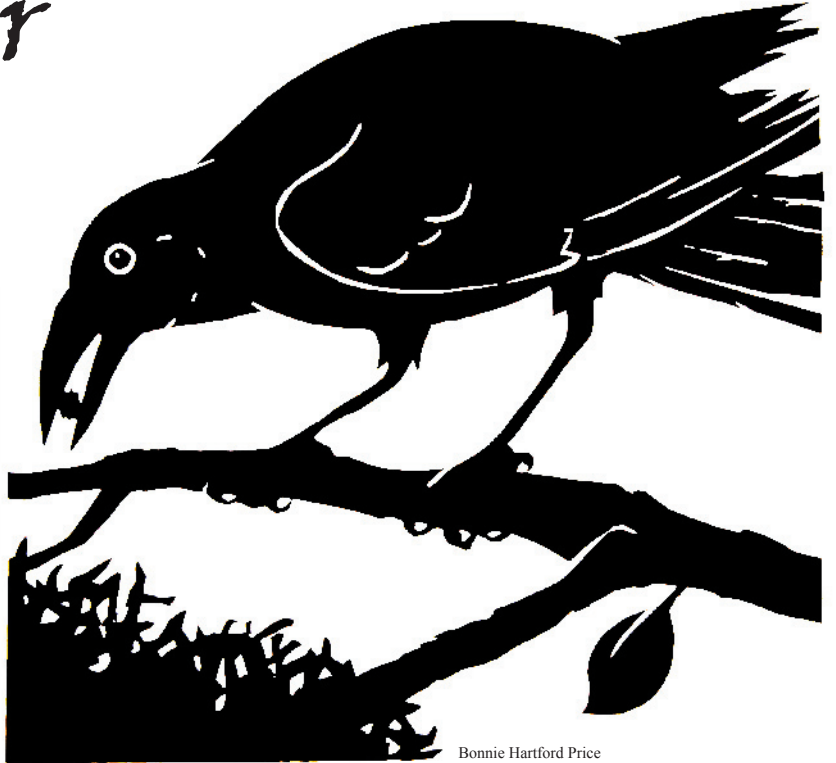

Eligibility

Artists eighteen and older are invited to submit work to the Ravin' for Poe. Work must be original to the artist and created in the last two years.

Categories

Entries may be two and three dimensional but limited to paintings, drawings, sculpture, print- making, photography, and fine craft.

Requirements

Participants may submit up to two (2) entries. All two dimensional entries must be ready to hang with picture wire on the back. No saw tooth hangers. We wish to accommodate artists in any way we are able, but we reserve the right to reject any entry that requires special installation. Artwork must relate to the writings of Edgar Allen Poe.

The Cleveland County Arts Council assumes responsibility for insuring and caring for the works of art selected for exhibition while they are in our possession. CCAC reserves the right to photograph and reproduce any entry submitted for educational or publicity purposes. The receipt of an entry in the exhibition constitutes agreement by the artist with all conditions set forth in this prospectus. Entries that don't meet these requirements cannot be accepted.
